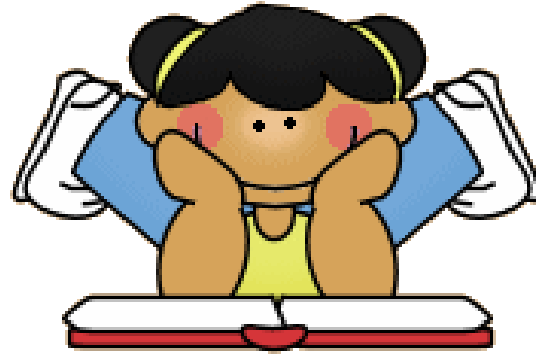

blend and digraph cards

These cards are perfect for a wall display, or to use as flashcards during Guided Reading groups.

I like to have a few sets...one for my wall, one to keep near my whole group rug, and one to keep at my table for reading groups. I laminate and hole punch the set of cards at the top left corner and put a ring on it. Throughout the year, I will scramble up the order. I will quickly flash them and sometimes the kiddos have to find the blend/digraph on their own chart, or tell me a word that starts with that blend/digraph.
