Swimming

Next week we will be starting swimming class. Our classes swimming days are on <u>days 3 and 6</u>. Children need to bring a waterproof swim bag filled with the following items:

- A black or dark blue one piece swimming suit
- A pair of swimming goggles
- A swim cap for any student with hair longer than their eyebrows
- A towel
- Waterproof sandals

Children need to be able to change into and out of their swim suits independently and pack away their wet clothing-please practice this skill at home. It is also extremely important that all of your child's clothing is labeled, so that fewer mix-ups happen. If students are not going to take part in swimming on a particular day, they must write a note explaining the reason the student will not be participating. Otherwise it is expected that all students bring their swimming gear every swimming day. Thank you for your support!
